3. Categories of events :

Friday 5th April

Referee seminar by Kyoshi 7th dan Yoshiyama Mitsuru sensei

- Participants must be holder of shodan dan or above dan grade.

Saturday 6th April

Women's Mudansha individual event

- Player must be 14 years old or above
- **No male players will be accepted to join in this event**
- There is no limitation on nationalities in joining this event
- Registered players and substitute must not hold any dan in Kendo;
- The four players making into semifinals in this event are eligible to join Women's 1st —2nd dan individual event later on the day

Men's Mudansha individual event

- Player must be 14 years old or above
 - **No female players will be accepted to join in this event**
 - There is no limitation on nationalities in joining this event
 - Registered players and substitute must not hold any dan in Kendo;
- The four players making into semifinals in this event are eligible to join Men's 1st —2nd dan individual event later on the day

Women's 1st —2nd dan individual event

- Player must be 14 years old or above
- **No male players will be accepted to join in this event**
- There is no limitation on nationalities in joining this event
- Registered players and substitute must be holder of 1Dan or 2Dan in Kendo;
- The four players making into semifinals in this event are eligible to join Women's individual event later on the day
- The four players making into semifinals in the Women's Mudansha Individual event are eligible to join this event.

Men's 1st —2nd dan individual event

- Player must be 14 years old or above
- **No female players will be accepted to join in this event**
- There is no limitation on nationalities in joining this event
- Registered players and substitute must be holder of 1Dan or 2Dan in Kendo;

- The four players making into semifinals in this event are eligible to join Men's individual event later on the day
- The four players making into semifinals in the Men's Mudansha Individual event are eligible to join this event.

Women's Individual event

- Player must be 14 years old or above
- **No male players will be accepted to join in this event**
- There is no limitation on nationalities in joining this event
- Registered players and substitute must be holder of 3Dan or above in Kendo;
- The four players making into semifinals in the Women's 1st —2nd dan Individual event are eligible to join this event.

Men's Individual event

- Player must be 14 years old or above
- **No female players will be accepted to join in this event**
- There is no limitation on nationalities in joining this event
- Registered players and substitute must be holder of 3Dan or above in Kendo;
- The four players making into semifinals in the Men's 1st —2nd dan Individual event are eligible to join this event.

Welcome party

- Venue to be announced

Sunday 7th April.

Women's 5—members team event :

- Each team will comprise 5 members and maximum of 2 registered substitute; Minimum of 3 members will be accepted;
- There is no limitation on dan grade or nationalities in joining this event.
- Player must be 14 years old or above
- **No male players will be accepted to join in this event;**
- **If any team is formed by only 3 members to compete in the 5—members team events, the sequences should be Senpo, Chuken and Taisho (1,3,5) only;**
- **If any team is formed by only 4 members to compete in the 5—members team events, the sequences should be Senpo, Chuken, Fukusho and Taisho (1,3,4,5) only;**
- **In the case your team will comprise less than 5 members, you may request the organizer to invite local members or members from other countries or areas to join your team;**
- Each match will be played by "3 Bon—Shobu";
- Team order (position of players) **CANNOT BE CHANGED** in the preliminary heats once the order list has been decided and submitted to the organizer no later than 7th April;
- In the preceding matches after the preliminary heats, team members and their order may be changed freely but only among the team's registered competitors (max. 4 registered members) submitted in their order list no later than 7th April;

- Each team **MUST** submit its order list (only if there are changes) in each match to the presiding referee (Shinpan—shunin) no later than the start of the matches before the team will play (i.e. if your team will play in the 2nd match and if you wish to make change of order lists or team members, you must submit the order lists immediately before the start of the 1st match);
- If the presiding referee (Shinpan—shunin) does not receive order list for the preceding match of your team, we would assume your team order list will be same as that of the previous match. Please inform your team(s) to cross check the order list on the scoreboard and if you see any mistake please inform the presiding referee (Shinpanshunin) immediately;
- The same player cannot participate in more than one team; whether as a player or substitute in the same event.
e.g. Miss SF Chan has registered as a player of Team B/Beijing, she cannot register as a player or substitute of Team C/Beijing, or she cannot register as a player or substitute of other teams in the same event.

Men's 5—members team events

- Each team will comprise 5 members and maximum of 2 registered substitutes; Minimum of 3 members will be accepted;
- There is no limitation on dan grade or nationalities in joining this event.
- Player must be 14 years old or above
- **No female players will be accepted to join in this event;**
- **If any team is formed by only 3 members to compete in the 5—members team events, the sequences should be Senpo, Chuken and Taisho (1,3,5) only;**
- **If any team is formed by only 4 members to compete in the 5—members team events, the sequences should be Senpo, Chuken, Fukusho and Taisho (1,3,4,5) only;**
- **In the case your team will comprise less than 5 members, you may request the organizer to invite local members or members from other countries or areas to join your team;**
- Each match will be played by "3 Bon—Shobu";
- Team order (position of players) **CANNOT BE CHANGED** in the preliminary heats once the order list has been decided and submitted to the organizer no later than 7th April;
- In the preceding matches after the preliminary heats, team members and their order may be changed freely but only among the registered competitors (max. 7 in the Men's 5—members team) submitted in their order list no later than 7th April;
- Each team **MUST** submit its order list (only if there are changes) in each match to the presiding referee (Shinpan—shunin) no later than the start of the matches before the team will play (i.e. if your team will play in the 2nd match and if you wish to make change of order lists or team members, you must submit the order lists before the start of the 1st match);

- If the presiding referee (Shinpan—shunin) do not receive order list for the preceding match of your team, we would assume your team order list will be same as that of the previous match. Please cross check the order list on the scoreboard and if you see any mistake please inform the presiding referee (Shinpan—shunin) immediately;
- The same player cannot participate in more than one team (either under same nation or other nation); whether as a player or substitute in the same event.
e.g. Mr SF Chan has registered as a player of Team B/HKG, he cannot register as a player or substitute of Team C/HKG, or he cannot register as a player or substitute of other teams in the same event.

4. Team event drawings will be conducted on 6th April Saturday evening during the welcome party. Please arrange your delegation representative to attend the drawings; otherwise the organizer will make the drawing on behalf of your delegation;

Individual event drawings will be arranged by organizer beforehand.

5. All matches shall be conducted following the latest "The Regulations of Kendo Shiai & Shinpan of FIK".

6. Each team (Ladies' & Men's events) must submit its order list **no later than 7th April**;

7. Shinai check - to be carried out on 6th April morning and 7th April morning. Players must bring the shinai that he/she will be using on the 6th and 7th April for check.

8. Referees

- We would appreciate volunteer referees with 4Dan or above in kendo from all participating delegations

- Any participant (4Dan & above) who have applied to be one of the fulltime referees in uniform that refereeing on both days and not participating competition as player and approved by the Organizer, his/her participation to Welcome party and Referee seminar on 5th April, 2019, shall be arranged through the courtesy of the Organizer.
 - A certificate and one souvenir shinai will be provided to each referee at the courtesy of the organizer
9. Trophies and certificates will be given to the winners, 2nd runner—up and Two 3rd places in all events. Referees and Shinpan—shunin from each court will nominate one member from each team who played in the same court for the Fighting Spirits Award.
 10. Lunch boxes will be provided by the organizer on 5th April to registered seminar participants only, on 6th April to registered individual players only, on 7th April to registered team players & substitutes only. Our helpers will arrange total number of lunch boxes as per your name lists and will hand over to your delegation.
 11. Method of Representative match (both men's & women's team event)
A play—off between the representatives of the teams will be carried out by "IPPON—SHOBU" and shall be continued until a winner is determined.
 12. The competitors must insure themselves against accident.
 13. Entry fee :
Referee seminar entry fee 200 RMB per head, including following items:
 - a) participation of referee seminar on 5th April, 2019
 - b) lunch boxes for 5th April
 Championships entry fee 450 RMB per head, including following items:
 - c) participation of both individual and team event
 - d) lunch boxes for 6th and 7th of April
 - e) souvenir T—shirt
 - f) souvenir tasuki(Mejirushi,white/red strip for competition)
 - g) welcome party on 6th April.
 14. **Deadline of entry : 22nd March 2019**
 15. Welcome Party on 6th April 2019, Saturday
Upon submission of your entries, please include how many members will attend the welcome Party. It is free for registered players and referees. For other personnel that are neither player nor referee, charge will be at 150.00RMB per head.
 16. For overseas delegations, charges for welcome party of non—player/referee personnel, if any, shall be settled together with entry fees upon arrival in Beijing.

Player entry fee will not be charged if organizing committee receives the cancellation notice on or before 22nd March 2019. Otherwise applicant needs to settle the full payment.

17. Due to the increasing convenience of online hotel reservation, visiting delegations are encouraged to arrange hotel by themselves. Please contact organizer for hotel reservation information if support is needed.
